Mission Statement:

The Guardian Peer Support and Mentor Group is a place for professional guardians around the State of Florida to share resources, discuss challenges, and uncover creative solutions to difficult issues to help support one another in a challenging and unique profession.

Slack Code of Conduct:

Slack is a workplace communication tool, used for chatting and messaging, sharing files, and collaborating. Slack can be accessed via an app on your cell phone, via a program on your computer, or online using a browser. Since the main purpose of Slack is communication, we ask that you adhere to the following rules when communicating within the group:

- **Tag / Categorize your posts first.** For ease of searchability, please add the category for the subject you are discussing first as a hashtag. #SUBJECT
 - **Category Hashtag List:**
 - #Property
 - #Financial
 - #Social
 - #Benefits
 - #Health
 - #Legal
 - #Administrative **Note:** Use this tag questions, resources, and discussion surrounding the business end of being a guardian and running a guardianship business
 - **Examples:**
 - #Property Does anyone have any good mobile jewelry appraisal resources in Brevard county?
 - #Financial I have a client with multiple investments and complicated financials. Anyone have a CPA they like working with for a financial forensic deep dive?
- **Don't use identifying names / information.** Do not list client names or give identifying information when discussing clients.
- **Be courteous and professional.** This is a group for professionals to come together and help one another. Please be respectful. Any member who is abusive, belligerent, or

disrespectful to other members of the group may be removed at the discretion of the group administrative team.

- **Have fun!** This is a support and mentor group by and of your peers. Connect, have fun, and be social. The more you interact, the more everyone will get out of the group.

Member Criteria:

Someone may be a member of the Guardian Peer Support and Mentor group if they meet the following criteria:

- Is a public or professional guardian in good standing with OPPG; **OR**
- Is a retired public or professional guardian, who was in good standing with OPPG at the time of their retirement, and who was recommended by a member of the group; **OR**
- A person in a Florida-recognized public office, such as law enforcement, or guardianship attorneys; allowed to join but participates in an advisory role only.
